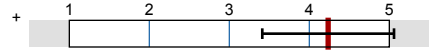

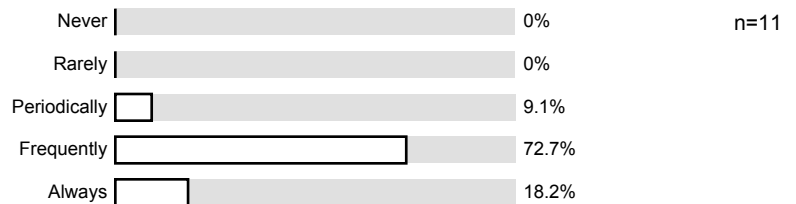

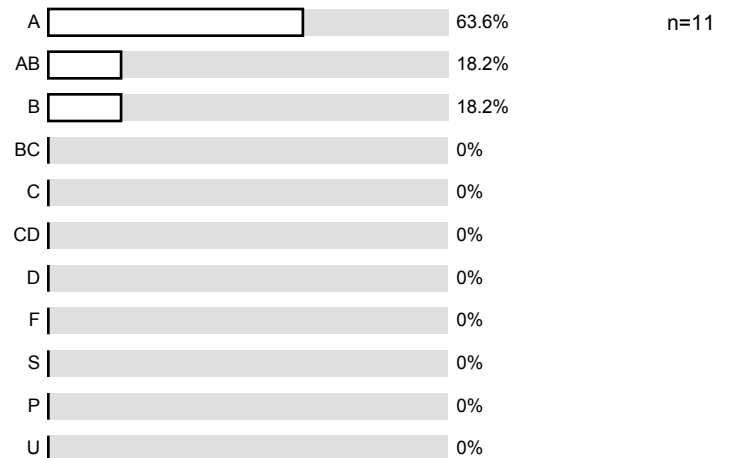
4.4) How often did you seek the professor's assistance?



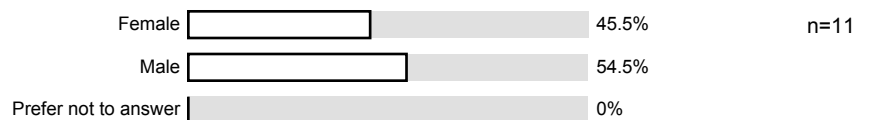

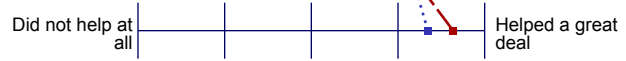

  - Ms. Davis tends to "hold our hands" alot. I would change that because the way she teaches the class, she should not have to do this. If she spent less time going over the same things in class, those of us who have questions about things that are not in the lectures would be able to challenge ourselves and learn more from the class. Also, it holds us back in developing our websites.
